PROVINCETOWN — William Wallace "Wally" O'Donnell, 99, of Provincetown, died Thursday, April 22, 2010, at Cape Cod Hospital.

He was the loving husband of Velmer M. (Perry) O'Donnell, to whom he had been married since 1951.

Born in Provincetown, he was the son of the late William and Susie (Newcomb) O'Donnell.
